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CARRIAGES, SLEIGHS AND VEHICLE SUPPLIES  
1944.

Ottawa, June, 1946. - The Carriage, Sleigh and Vehicle Supply Industry includes establishments engaged wholly or chiefly in the manufacture of complete vehicles, such as carriages, wagons and sleighs; or vehicle supplies, such as spokes, hubs, rims, axles and other wooden parts. Small repair shops have been excluded.

There were 55 establishments in this group in 1944 distributed as follows:  
Quebec 29, Ontario 11, Nova Scotia 4,  
Prince-Edward Island 4, Manitoba 3, New  
Brunswick 2, Saskatchewan 1 and Alberta 1.

The Table below gives the principal statistics of the industry for 1943 and 1944 and shows decreases for all items, except wage-earners, wages paid, cost of materials and value of products.

There are a number of other establishments classed in other industrial groups which make relatively small quantities of vehicles and vehicle supplies as a side line. Complete figures on the production of vehicles and vehicle supplies by all industrial groups and further details concerning this groups will be given in a later report on the wood-using industries as a whole.

VOITURES, TRAINEAUX ET PIECES DE CHARRONNERIE, 1944.

Ottawa, juin 1946. - L'industrie des voitures, traîneaux et pièces de charbonnerie comprend les établissements dont l'occupation exclusive ou principale consiste dans la fabrication de véhicules complets, comme les voitures, charrettes et traîneaux, ou de pièces de charbonnerie, comme les rais, moyeux, jantes, essieux et autres pièces en bois. Les petits ateliers de réparation ont été exclus.

Il y avait 55 établissements dans ce groupe en 1944, distribués comme suit:

the following will be well worth considering as regards the possible connection between the two components of Respiration. The following table gives the results of some of the experiments which have been made by Dr. J. C. Dill and myself.

In this table the first column shows the time required for the absorption of oxygen by the blood, the second the amount of oxygen absorbed per unit of time, and the third the amount of oxygen absorbed per unit of time per unit of surface.

These last three columns are probably the most important, as they indicate the rate at which oxygen is being absorbed, and the amount of oxygen absorbed per unit of time per unit of surface.
