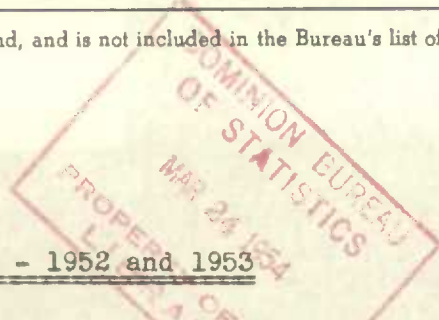

Production of grinding balls in Canada totalled 27,978 net tons in 1953 compared with 34,751 net tons in 1952. The 1953 output included 14,178 net tons of cast iron and cast steel balls and 13,800 net tons of forged steel balls.
