

FEBRUARY, 1949




Production of domestic type electric refrigerators in Canada totalled 13,319 units in February, 1949, compared with 13,331 units in January, 1949.

Imports of complete electric refrigerators of all types during February, 1949, numbered 17 units valued at \$2,546 as against 24 units valued at \$3,135 in January, 1949.
