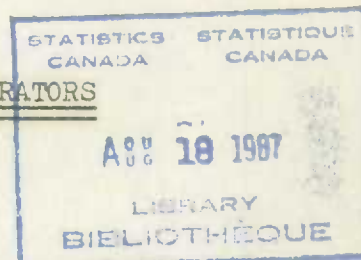

DOMESTIC WASHING MACHINES AND ELECTRIC REFRIGERATORSMay - 1949

Production of domestic type washing machines totalled 29,782 units in May, 1949 compared with 24,716 in May, 1948. For the first five months of this year the total was 154,644 units, an increase of 22 per cent over the number made in the corresponding period of 1948.

Output of household electric refrigerators during the current month amounted to 13,836 units, an increase of 25 per cent over the number made in May, 1948. The cumulative total for the first five months of this year was 68,966 units and for last year the comparative figure was 53,882 units.
