DOMESTIC WASHING MACHINES AND ELECTRIC

FERRUARY - 1950

Production of domestic type washing machines totalled 19,267 units in February, 1950 compared with 29,341 in February, 1949. For the first two months of this year the total was 44,944 units, a decrease of 27 per cent from the number made in the corresponding period of 1949.

Output of household electric refrigerators during the current month amounted to 21,410 units, an increase of 38 per cent over the number made in February, 1949. The cumulative total for the first two months of this year was 38,945 units and for last year the comparative figure was 26,650 units.


