DOMESTIC WASHING MACHINES AND ELECTRIC REFRIGERATORS

MARCH - 1950

Production of domestic type washing machines totalled 20,434 units in March, 1950 compared with 34,105 in March, 1949. For the first three months of this year the total was 65,378 units, a decrease of 31 per cent from the number made in the corresponding period of 1949.

Output of household electric refrigerators during the current month amounted to 26,795 units, an increase of 41 per cent over the number made in March, 1949. The cumulative total for the first three months of this year was 66,020 units and for last year the comparative figure was 42,530 units.


