DOMESTIC WASHING MACHINES AND ELECTRIC REFRIGERATORS

APRIL - 1950

Production of domestic type washing machines totalled 19,109 units in April, 1950 compared with 29,330 in April, 1949. For the first four months of this year the total was 84,487 units, a decrease of 32 per cent from the number made in the corresponding period of 1949.

Output of household electric refrigerators during the current month amounted to 25,237 units, an increase of 50 per cent over the number made in April, 1949. The cumulative total for the first four months of this year was 91,257 units, and for last year the comparative figure was 55,130 units.
