Production of domestic type washing machines totalled 22,359 units in May, 1950 compared with 29,782 in May, 1949. For the first five months of this year the total was 106,846 units, a decrease of 31 per cent from the number made in the corresponding period of 1949.

Output of household electric refrigerators during the current month amounted to 32,350 units, an increase of 57 per cent over the number made in May, 1949. The cumulative total for the first five months of this year was 123,607 units, and for last year the comparative figure was 68,966 units.


