

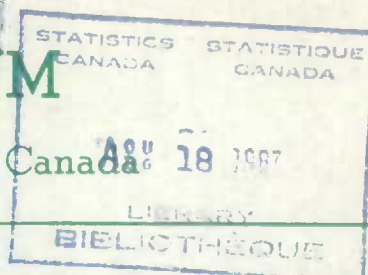
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DOMESTIC WASHING MACHINES AND ELECTRIC REFRIGERATORSFEBRUARY - 1951

Production of domestic type washing machines totalled 27,017 units in February, 1951 compared with 19,267 units in February, 1950. For the first two months of this year the total was 57,722 units, an increase of 29 per cent from the number made in the corresponding period of 1950.

Output of household electric refrigerators during the current month amounted to 31,985 units, an increase of 49 per cent over the number made in February, 1950. The cumulative total for the first two months of this year was 66,850 units, and for last year the comparative figure was 38,945 units.
