BIELIOTHEQUE

Production of domestic type washing machines totalled 27,236 units in May, 1951 compared with 22,359 units in May, 1950. For the first 5 months of this year the total was 144,801 units, an increase of 36 per cent from the number made in the corresponding period of 1950.

Output of household electric refrigerators during the current month amounted to 32,948 units, an increase of 2 per cent over the number made in May, 1950. The cumulative total for the first 5 months of this year was 169,415 units, and for last year the comparative figure was 123,607 units.
