## RADIO AND TELEVISION RECEIVING SETS

Sales of radio receiving sets by Canadian producers during January, 1955, totalled 30,097 units valued at $\$ 2,040,731$ at list prices. Home sets totalled 16,466 units; portable and automobile sets totalled 10,354 units and combinations totalled 3,277 units.

Sales of tolevision sets totalled 54,788 units of which 31,663 were table models; 22,337 were consoles and 788 were threeway combinations. In dollar value the January, 1955, sales of televiaion sets totalled $\$ 17,724,238$.
