## OTTAWA - CANADA

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## RADIO AND TELEVISION RECEIVING SETS

Sales of radio receiving sets by Canadian producers during February, 1955, totalled 39,911 units valued at $\$ 3,358,836$ at list prices. Home sets totalled 19,466 units; portable and automobile sets totalled 17,160 units and combinations totalled 3,285 units.

Sales of television sets totalled 56,829 units of which 34,317 were table models; 22,023 were consoles and 489 were three-way combinations. In dollar value the February, 1955, sales of television sots totalled $\$ 18,133,434$.
