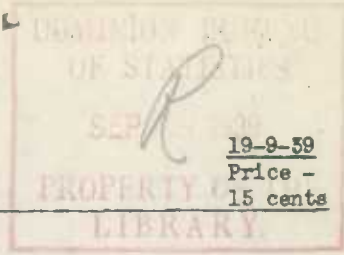

QUARTERLY REPORT

PRODUCTION and SALES OF RADIO RECEIVING SETS

APRIL, MAY and JUNE, 1939.

Production of radio receiving sets in Canada during the second quarter of 1939 amounted to 68,189 sets with a factory selling value of \$1,261,158. During the preceding three months output totalled 55,611 sets worth \$806,085 and for April, May and June of 1938 the production was reported at 51,185 sets worth \$1,562,875 at factory prices.

Manufacturers' sales during the quarter under review numbered 52,895 sets listed at \$2,470,697 against second quarter sales in the previous year of 30,719 sets at \$2,170,919. Data for the second quarter of this year, when compared with the figures for the corresponding period of 1938, showed increased sales across Canada. In Ontario the sales advanced to 23,246 from 14,284, in Quebec to 11,259 from 6,356, in British Columbia to 4,094 from 1,784, in Saskatchewan and Alberta to 6,689 from 3,857, in Manitoba to 4,441 from 2,637 and in the Maritimes to 3,166 from 1,801.

Inventories of radio receiving sets in the hands of Canadian producers stood at 66,643 on June 30th, 1939, against 50,175 on hand at the end of March.
