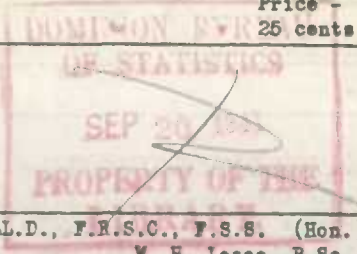

QUARTERLY REPORT

PRODUCTION and SALE OF RADIO RECEIVING SETS

APRIL, MAY and JUNE, 1941

Sales of radio receiving sets in Canada during April, May and June 1941 numbered 83,215 sets worth \$4,351,010 at list prices. In the preceding quarter sales by producers amounted to 77,121 sets and in the second quarter of a year ago to 85,937 sets.

Compared with corresponding data of a year ago, sales figures for the period under review show that the number of sets sold in Ontario advanced to 38,790 from 37,278 and in Manitoba to 6,683 from 5,598 while declines were recorded for all other areas. In the Maritimes the drop was to 6,847 from 7,739, in Quebec to 14,452 from 15,319, in Saskatchewan and Alberta to 8,052 from 10,733 and in British Columbia to 8,391 from 9,270.

Customs figures show that during the second quarter of 1941 a total of 1,019 sets were imported into Canada, including 584 which came in under special conditions. During the same period the imports of radio tubes numbered 354,525.

Inventories of radio receivers at the producing factories or their branches and in jobbers' hands on June 30, 1941, were reported at 90,083 sets against stocks of 80,883 sets at the end of March.
