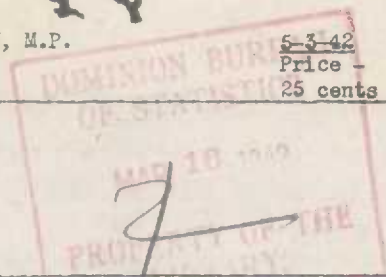

QUARTERLY REPORT

PRODUCTION AND SALE OF RADIO RECEIVING SETS

OCTOBER, NOVEMBER and DECEMBER, 1941

During October, November and December of 1941 the sales of radio receivers by Canadian producers numbered 118,647 sets valued at \$7,370,347 at list prices. In the previous quarter, Canadian manufacturers sold 120,573 sets valued at \$7,111,895, and in the final quarter of 1940 their sales amounted to 164,670 sets at \$9,660,869.

For the entire year 1941, the producers' sales in Canada totalled 399,556 sets compared with 438,976 sets in 1940 and 370,568 sets in 1939. Ontario took 182,505 sets in 1941 or 45.6 per cent of the total; Quebec took 75,895 sets or 19.0 per cent; the Maritimes, 37,015 sets or 9.3 per cent; British Columbia, 35,017 sets or 8.7 per cent; Manitoba, 32,421 sets or 8.1 per cent, and Alberta and Saskatchewan, 36,703 sets or 9.3 per cent.

Customs' records show that 967 complete receiving sets were imported into Canada during the final quarter of 1941, bringing the total for the year to 4,022 sets as against 36,062 sets in 1940.

Radio inventories at the producing plants or their branches, or in jobbers' hands on December 31, 1941 totalled 50,123 sets.
