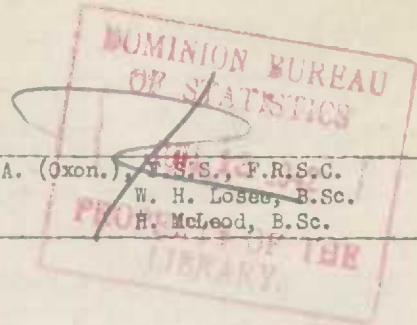

QUARTERLY REPORT

PRODUCTION AND SALE OF RADIO RECEIVING SETS

JANUARY, FEBRUARY AND MARCH, 1942

Sales of radio receiving sets in Canada during January, February and March of 1942 numbered 87,953 sets valued at \$6,421,165 at manufacturers' list prices. In the preceding quarter, sales by producers amounted to 118,647 sets, and in the first quarter of 1941 to 61,038 sets.

Sales in Ontario advanced to 43,522 sets from 38,437 sets in the corresponding quarter of last year. In Manitoba the increase was to 6,780 from 5,736; in Quebec to 15,904 from 13,956; in Alberta to 4,847 from 5,277, and in British Columbia to 6,802 from 5,256. In the Maritime Provinces there was a drop in sales to 7,171 sets from 7,511, and in Saskatchewan a decline to 2,927 from 2,948.

Customs figures show that during the first quarter of 1942 a total of 811 sets were imported into Canada, including 509 which came in under special conditions. During the same period the imports of radio receiving tubes totalled 538,354 units.

Inventories of radio sets at the producing factories or their branches and in jobbers' hands on March 31, 1942 totalled 50,910 sets.
