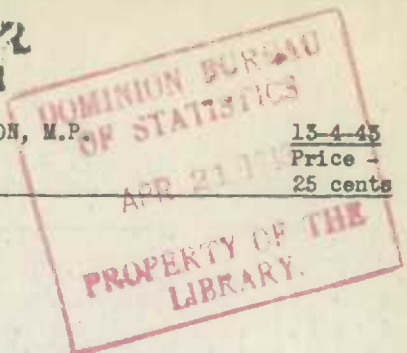

QUARTERLY REPORT

PRODUCTION AND SALE OF RADIO RECEIVING SETS

OCTOBER, NOVEMBER AND DECEMBER, 1942

During October, November and December of 1942 sales of radio receiving sets by Canadian manufacturers numbered 30,181 units valued at \$1,867,835 at list prices. In the corresponding period of 1941, the producers sold 118,647 sets.

Sales figures for this year, when compared with those of 1941, show a decrease in all provinces. In the Maritimes the number of sets sold dropped to 17,679 from 37,015; in Quebec, to 38,797 from 75,895; in Ontario to 94,676 from 182,505; in Manitoba to 20,175 from 32,421; in Saskatchewan to 7,527 from 16,480; in Alberta to 11,769 from 20,223, and in British Columbia to 18,540 from 35,017.

Imports into Canada during the final quarter of 1942 totalled 433 sets, including 224 which were brought in by Canadians returning from other countries, bringing the total for the year to 2,652 sets as against 4,022 sets in 1941.

Inventories of radio receivers at the producing factories and their branches and in jobbers' hands amounted to 13,685 sets on December 31, against stocks of 32,282 sets at the end of the previous quarter.
