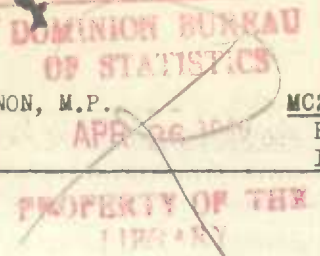

MONTHLY REPORT

on

RADIO RECEIVING SETS

JANUARY, 1946

This report is the first of a new monthly series covering producers' sales of radio receiving sets in Canada. The last published report was for the final quarter of 1942 as the manufacture of civilian sets was discontinued in that year for the duration of the war.

The number of sets sold by producers in January, 1946 was 31,659 and their value at list prices was \$1,081,125. The distribution by provinces was as follows: Ontario 13,767 units; Quebec 5,615; British Columbia 3,275; Maritimes 3,030; Manitoba 2,432; Alberta 1,994, and Saskatchewan 1,546. About 75 per cent, or 23,757 units, were standard electric table models; 11 per cent were short wave table models; 9 per cent were standard battery table models; 4 per cent were portable battery sets, and 0.5 per cent were short wave console models. Only 6 standard combinations were sold in January.
