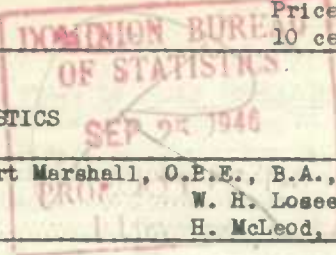

MONTHLY REPORT

ON

RADIO RECEIVING SETS

JULY, 1946

Sales of radio receiving sets by Canadian producers totalled 60,022 units in July compared with 29,493 units in June and 44,954 units in May.

The provincial distribution of the July sales was as follows: Ontario, 29,665; Quebec, 10,361; Manitoba, 4,952; Maritimes, 4,465; Alberta, 3,339; British Columbia, 4,143 and Saskatchewan, 3,097.
