RADIO RECEIVING SETS

SEPTEMBER - 1948

Sales of radio receiving sets by Canadian producers during September, 1948, totalled 78,228 units valued at \$6,099,765 at list prices. The provincial distribution of sales was as follows: Ontario, 33,226; Quebec, 16,169; British Columbia, 5,871; Manitoba, 6,080; Maritimes, 5,366; Alberta, 6,919; and Saskatchewan, 4,597.
