## RADIO AND TELEVISION RECEIVING SETS

Sales of radio receiving sets by Canadian producers during January, 1954, totalled 35, 863 units valued at $\$ 2,940,238$ at list prices. The provincial distribution of sales was as follows: Ontario, l6,2l8; Quebec, 5,667; British Columbia, 2,214; Manitoba, 3,762; Atlantic Provinces, 2,977; Alberta, 3,204 and Saskatchewan, 1,821.

Sales of television sets totalled 34,396 sets, of which 18,631 were table models, 14,676 were consoles and 1,089 were three -way combinations. The provincial distribution of these sales was as follows: Ontario, 18,321; Quebec, 13,110; British Columbia, 2,589; Atlantic Provinces, 200; and Prairie Provinces, 176. In dollar value the January sales of television sets totalled $\$ 12,684,669$.
