FACTORY SALES OF ELECTRIC STORAGE BATTERIES

AUGUST - 1950

Sales of electric storage batteries and parts by principal Canadian producers were valued at \$1,611,704 during August, 1950 compared with \$1,521,662 during August, 1949. The sales for August, 1950 included 160,618 batteries at \$1,387,800 for the ignition of internal combustion engines; 3,685 cells at \$35,886 for farm lighting plants; 1,224 cells at \$48,877 for railway services; 1,150 batteries at \$3,935 for radios; batteries valued at \$101,584 for other purposes, including those for telephone switchboards and motorcycles, and miscellaneous parts and supplies for batteries valued at \$33,622.
