FACTORY SALES OF ELECTRIC STORAGE BATTERIES IN CANADA

THIRD QUARTER, 1935.

Factory sales of electric storage batteries and parts in Canada during July, August and September were valued at \$770,518 compared with sales of \$807,914 in the previous quarter and \$751,626 in the third quarter of a year ago.

Sales for the quarter under review included 131,752 batteries for the starting or ignition of internal combustion engines, 4,337 cells for farm lighting plants, 1,414 cells for railway service, 1,160 batteries for motor cycle starting, \$56,231 worth of batteries for miscellaneous purposes, and \$81,024 worth of battery parts and supplies.

Imports of storage batteries and parts into Canada during the third quarter of this year were appraised at \$67,749 and exports during the same period were reported at \$135,765.
