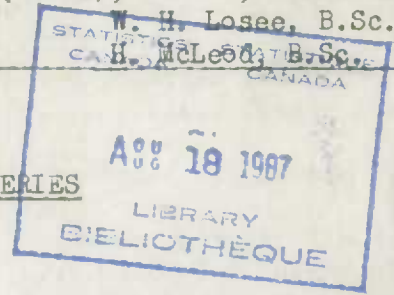

FACTORY SALES OF ELECTRIC STORAGE BATTERIES
FOURTH QUARTER, 1941

Sales of electric storage batteries and parts by 10 producers who normally account for 98 per cent of the total Canadian output were valued at \$1,996,008 during the fourth quarter of this year, compared with sales amounting to \$1,565,996 during the previous quarter and to \$1,667,443 in the final quarter of 1940.

For the calendar year 1941, the sales by Canadian producers included 1,001,408 batteries at \$4,485,627 for the starting and ignition of internal combustion engines, 37,572 cells at \$238,309 for farm lighting plants, 4,665 cells at \$86,539 for railway service, 6,038 cells at \$22,064 for motor cycle starting, parts and supplies at \$903,214, and batteries unclassified as to purpose at \$713,232.
