QUARTERLY REPORT

FACTORY SALES OF ELECTRIC STORAGE BATTERIES

FOURTH QUARTER, 1945

Sales of electric storage batteries and parts by principal Canadian producers were valued at \$2,622,753 during the fourth quarter of 1945, compared with \$2,402,117 in the third quarter of 1945 and with \$2,665,430 in the fourth quarter of 1944. Sales for the quarter under review included 360,867 batteries at \$2,033,478 for the ignition of internal combustion engines; 1,504 batteries at \$5,333 for motor cycle starting; 26,221 cells at \$195,654 for farm lighting plants; 2,343 cells at \$70,596 for rail-way service; batteries valued at \$276,403 for other purposes, including those for telephone switchboards, and miscallaneous parts and supplies for batteries valued at \$41,289.
