Sales of electric storage batteries and parts by principal Canadian producers were valued at \$829,603 during January 1946, and \$774,357 during February. The sales for February included 109,292 batteries at \$581,616 for the ignition of internal combustion engines; 3,070 batteries at \$59,794 for motor cycle starting; 746 cells at \$16,346 for farm lighting plants; 1,264 cells at \$4,984 for railway service; batteries valued at \$90,069 for other purposes, including those for telephone switchboards, and miscellaneous parts and supplies for batteries valued at \$21.548.
