Sales of electric storage batteries and parts by principal Canadian producers were valued at \$1,060,236 during October, 1946, compared with \$1,016,172 during September, 1946. The sales for October included 155,504 batteries at \$834,098 for the ignition of internal combustion engines; 453 batteries at \$1,897 for motorcycle starting; 9,908 cells at \$65,193 for farm lighting plants; 964 cells at \$20,500 for railway services; batteries valued at \$93,171 for other purposes, including those for telephone switchboards, and miscellaneous parts and supplies for batteries valued at \$45,377.
