FACTORY SALES OF ELECTRIC STORAGE BATTERIES

AUGUST. 1946



Sales of electric storage batteries and parts by principal Canadian producers were valued at \$890,782 during August, 1946, compared with \$641,072 in July, 1946. The sales for August included 130:860 batteries at \$708.394 for the ignition of internal combustion engines; 453 batteries at \$2,035 for motorcycle, starting; 8,537 cells at \$63,257 for farm lighting plants; 810 cells at \$14,370 for railway services; batteries valued at \$61,777 for other purposes, including those for telephone switchboards, and miscellaneous parts and supplies for batteries valued at \$40,949.
