FACTORY SALES OF ELECTRIC STORAGE BATTERIES

APRIL, 1947.

Sales of electric storage batteries and parts by principal Canadian producers were valued at \$984,445 during April, 1947, compared with \$1,039,385 in March, 1947. The sales for April, 1947, included 113,721 batteries at \$757,241 for the ignition of internal combustion engines, 659 batteries at \$3,680 for motorcycle starting, 4,067 cells at \$26,561 for farm lighting plants, 1,506 cells at \$46,492 for railway services, batteries valued at \$102,777 for other purposes, including those for telephone switchboards, and miscellaneous parts and supplies for batteries valued at \$47,694.
