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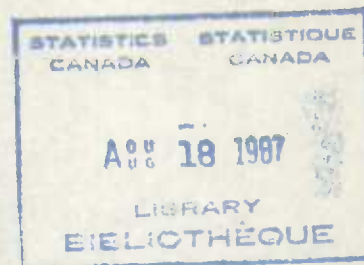

Sales of electric storage batteries and parts by principal Canadian producers were valued at \$1,004,018 during May, 1947, compared with \$984,445 in April, 1947. The sales for May, 1947, included 106,657 batteries at \$765,260 for the ignition of internal combustion engines, 1,137 batteries at \$5,212 for motorcycle starting, 2,927 cells at \$28,512 for farm lighting plants, 1,106 cells at \$32,923 for railway services, batteries valued at \$134,051 for other purposes, including those for telephone switchboards, and miscellaneous parts and supplies for batteries valued at \$38,060.
