## FACTORY SALES OF ELECTRIC STORAGE BATTERIES

JUNE, 1947

Sales of electric storage batteries and parts by principal Canadian producers were valued at \$1,034,217 during June, 1947, compared with \$1,004,018 in May, 1947. The sales for June, 1947 included 106,387 batteries at \$808,797 for the ignition of internal combustion engines, 959 batteries at \$5,299 for motorcycle starting, 2,561 cells at \$31,670 for farm lighting plants, 953 cells at \$19,545 for railway services, batteries valued at \$104,303 for other purposes, including those for telephone switchboards, and miscellaneous parts and supplies for batteries at \$64.603.
