Sales of electric storage batteries and parts by principal Canadian producers were valued at \$1,055,022 during May, 1948 compared with \$1,187,950 in April, 1948. The sales for May, 1948 included 95,418 batteries at \$800,185 for the ignition of internal combustion engines, 612 batteries at \$2,989 for motorcycle starting, 2,098 cells at \$22,056 for farm lighting plants, 538 cells at \$19,376 for railway services, batteries valued at \$171,653 for other purposes, including those for telephone switchboards, and miscellaneous parts and supplies for batteries valued at \$38,763.


