Sales of electric storage batteries and parts by principal Canadian producers were valued at \$741,503 during July, 1948 compared with \$1,199,133 in June, 1948. The sales for July, 1948 included 65,223 batteries at \$579,362 for the ignition of internal combustion engines, 41 batteries at \$387 for motorcycle starting, 2,731 cells at \$28,483 for farm lighting plants, 290 cells at \$12,369 for railway services, batteries valued at \$70,303 for other purposes, including those for telephone switchboards, and miscellaneous parts and supplies for batteries valued at \$50,599


