FACTORY SALES OF ELECTRIC STORAGE BATTERIES

OCTOBER - 1949

Sales of electric storage batteries and parts by principal Canadian producers were valued at \$1,640,210 during October, 1949 compared with \$1,796,518 during October, 1948. The sales for October, 1949 included 151,916 batteries at \$1,339,328 for the ignition of internal combustion engines; 147 batteries at \$1,365 for motorcycles; 5,564 cells at \$54,654 for farm lighting plants; 1,262 cells at \$39,196 for railway services; batteries valued at \$162,386 for other purposes, including those for telephone switchboards, and miscellaneous parts and supplies for batteries valued at \$45,281.
