FACTORY SALES OF ELECTRIC STORAGE BATTERIES

SEPTE BER - 1949

Sales of electric storage batteries and parts by principal Canadian producers were valued at \$1,768,403 during September, 1949 compared with \$1,757,565 during September, 1948. The sales for September, 1949 included 163,591 batteries at \$1,413,214 for the ignition of internal combustion engines; 68 batteries at \$660 for motorcycle starting; 5,223 cells at \$54,276 for farm lighting plants; 1,406 cells at \$50,564 for railway services; batteries valued at \$200,863 for other purposes, including those for telephone switchboards, and miscellaneous parts and supplies for batteries valued at \$48,826.
