## FACTORY SALES OF ELECTRIC STORAGE BATTERIES

Sales of electric storage batteries and parts by principal Canadian producers were valued at \$3,064,609 during November, 1955, compared with \$2,070,284 during November, 1954. The sales for November, 1955, included 252,668 batteries at \$2,600,985 for the ignition of internal combustion engines for passenger cars and light trucks; 1,971 cells at \$22,556 for farm lighting plants; 1,106 cells at \$54,473 for railway service; batteries valued at \$318,615 for all other purposes, including telephone switchboards, direct motive power and ignition of internal combustion engines other than passenger cars and light trucks; and miscellaneous parts and supplies at \$52,063.
