### THE ELECTRICAL APPARATUS INDUSTRY, 1918.

A preliminary report on the above industry for the calendar year 1918 has been completed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, covering the operations of 68 plants. Distributed according to location, Ontario had 42 plants, Quebec 13, Manitoba 7, British Columbia 3, Alberta 2 and Saskatchewan 1.

#### Capital Investment.

The total capital investment for the Dominion was \$43,285,405, of which \$10,636,572 was in land, buildings and fixtures; \$6,518,132 in machinery and tools; \$17,071,528 in mater; ials, stocks in process, finished products, fuel and miscellaneous supplies on hand as per inventory; and \$9,059,173 in working capital. Of the total investment, Ontario contributed \$26,426,129, Quebec \$16,525,454, Manitoba \$253,026, British Columbia \$42,881, Alberta \$19,736 and Saskatchewan \$18,179.

## Employees, Salaries and Wages.

The number of persons at employment by classes and by sex, together with the amounts paid to each class in salaries or wages are shown in the following tabular statement:-



### Fuel Consumption.

The total value of all fuel used during the year amounted to \$497,074, of which \$87,325 was of Canadian origin and \$409,749 of foreign origin. Coal used amounted to 52,328 tons valued at \$328,165; coke,1,880 tons valued at \$21,310; gasoline 15,120 gallons worth \$5,528; fuel oil 373,681 gallons worth \$41,-607; wood 237 cords worth \$1,928; gas, natural and artificial, 24,814 m. cubic feet worth \$27,106; and other fuel for which no uantity is given to the value of \$17,430.

### Miscellaneous Expenses.

The outlay under this heading for the year amounted to \$4,380,448, and comprised the following items - rent of offices, works, cic., \$296,975; rent of power \$263,358; insurance premiums \$127,048; taxes (internal revenue, war, etc.) \$227,659; taxes (municipal provincial, etc.) \$161,890; royalties, use of patents, etc. \$20.125; advertising expenses \$160,064; travelling expenses \$187,844; ordinary repairs to buildings and plants \$1,025,669, and all other sundry expenses \$1,909,816.
