DRY.CELL BATTERIES, 1933 and 1934.

Factory sales of dry cell batteries in Canada during 1934 totalled over twenty-three million cells with a factory selling price of \$1,649,791. In 1933 sales were reported at over twenty-one million cells worth \$1,543,795.

Sales figures for "B" and "C" radio batteries improved to 14,595,117 cells from 13,538,623 in 1933, and flashlight cells advanced to 7,231,114 from 6,347,659 while six inch cells fell off slightly to 1,460,949 from 1,524,714.
