DOMESTIC WASHING MACHINES, 1946

The production of domestic type washing machines by Canadian producers during 1946 amounted to 115,055 units valued at \$8,231,367. This total included 96,249 electric machines worth \$7,068.269; 8,209 hand-operated machines at \$126,820, and 10,595 gasoline-operated machines at \$1,036,278.

Imports in 1946 of electric washing machines and parts were valued at \$976,567 and imports of washing machines, other than electric, totalled \$145,401. Exports of domestic washing machines and parts were appraised at \$443,472 in 1946.
