ELECTRIC VACUUM CLEANERS - 1939

Factory sales of electric vacuum cleaners and parts totalled \$1,729,508 in 1939 compared with \$1,786,221 in 1938. Sales of floor models were higher in 1939 at 44,767 units worth \$1,560,838 compared with 42,843 units at \$1,535,993 in the previous year while shipments of hand models declined to 2,948 machines valued at \$27,629 from 4,740 machines at \$50,794 in 1938. Sales of parts and attachments were valued at \$141,041 in 1939 and at \$199,454 in 1938.
