CEMENT, CLAY PRODUCTS AND LIME PRODUCTION, OCTOBER, 1933.

CEMENT - Shipments of Portland cement by Canadian producers in October amounted to 348,639 barrels; in the preceding month 424,710 barrels were shipped and in October, 1932, the total was 413,258 barrels, according to a report issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the ten months ending October, sales totalled 2,726,018 barrels as compared with 4,221,088 barrels in the corresponding period of 1932.

Portland cement exports were recorded at 5,228 barrels; in September, 5,968 barrels were exported. Imports of cement advanced to 3,081 barrels worth \$5,571 from the September total of 2,334 barrels at \$5,490. The October importations were received from the following countries: Great Britain, 84.5 per cent; the United States, 14.5 per cent; and France, the remainder.



CLAY PRODUCTS - Canadian producers sold clay and clay products valued at \$231,526 in October, in September the total was \$253,433 and in October, a year ago, \$299,319. A 43.8 per cent decline was recorded in the sales of these commodities during the first ten months of 1933 as compared with the corresponding period of 1932; the totals were \$1,852,621 and \$3,298,418, respectively.

Clay and clay products exported from Canada in October were valued at \$13,072 or 10.7 per cent above the September total of \$11,813. Receipts of clay and clay products during October were appraised at \$502,716 as compared with \$436,128 in the preceding month. The October importations were drawn from the following sources: Great Britain, 49.0 per cent; the United States, 37.3 per cent; Japan, 8.3 per cent; Germany, 2.4 per cent: Palestine, 0.9 per cent; France, 0.8 per cent; Czechoslovakia 0.7 per cent; and Belgium, Italy, China, Denmark, the Netherlands, Hong Kong, Austria and Sweden, the remainder.

LIME - The production of lime in Canada during October amounted to 33,686 tons as against 28,601 tons in the previous month and 34,222 tons in October, 1932. During the first ten months of 1933 the Canadian production totalled 248,007 tons; in the corresponding period of 1932 the output was 273,962 tons.

Lime exports in October declined to 882 tons from the proceding month's total of 1,476 tons. Imports of lime into Canada in October advanced to 37 tons worth \$582 from the September total of 6 tons valued at \$155.
