LIME - The Canadian production of lime in April totalled 21,752 tons as against 15,482 tons in March and 26, 744 tons in April, 1932.

Lime exports were recorded at 600 tons with a valuation of $\$ 11,157$; in March, 993 tons worth $\$ 19,030$ were exported. Thirty-two tons of lime appraised at $\$ 583$ were imported into Canada in April.
