## CEMENT, CLAY PRODUCTS AND LINE PRODUCTION, JUNE AND JULY, 1933.

CEMENT - Sales of Portland cement by Canadian producers amounted to 401,060 barrels in June and 414,827 barrels in July, according to a report issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. In 1932 the June sales totalled 570,618 barrels and the July, 460,170 barrels. During the first seven months of 1933, shipments were recorded at 1,503,364 barrels as compared with 2,782,574 barrels a year ago.

Exports of Portland cement from Canada in June were recorded at 3,736 barrels; in July 4,214 barrels were exported. Cement imports into Canada in June totalled 1,837 barrels of which Great Britain supplied 52.8 per cent, Belgium, 38.3 per cent and the United States the remainder. The July importations amounted to 3,186 barrels made up of 83.4 per cent from Great Britain, 15.6 per cent from the United States and 1.0 per cent from Italy.



Exports of clay and clay products from Canada in June were valued at \$10,838; the July valuation was \$4,286. Canada imported clay and clay products appraised at \$405,111 in June and \$416,208 in July. The June importations were obtained from the following sources: Great Britain, 53.0 per cent; the United States, 30.6 per cent; Japan, 11.0 per cent; and Germany, Czechostovakia, France, Italy, Belgium, Palestine, Hong Kong, Sweden, China, the Netherlands and Austria, the remainder. Great Britain, the United States and Japan were the principal sources of the July imports.

LIME - Lime producers in Canada reported shipments totalling 26,872 tons in June and 29,443 tons in July as compared with 26,820 tons and 26,717 tons, respectively, in 1932. Shipments during the seven months ending July, 1933, were recorded at 155,122 tons; in the corresponding months of the previous year 184,427 tons were shipped.

Exports of lime from Canada in June amounted to 1,505 tons and in July, 1,444 tons. Thirty-two tons of lime were imported into Canada in June while in July receipts totalled 68 tons.
