## CEMENT, CLAY PRODUCTS AND LINE PRODUCTION, SEPTEMBER, 1933.

CEMENT - Canadian producers reported shipments of Portland cement totalling 424,710 barrels in September as compared with 449,305 barrels in August and 511,897 barrels in September, 1932, according to a report issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the nine months ending September sales aggregated 2,377,379 barrels or 37.6 per cent below the total for the corresponding period of 1932.

Exports of Portland cement from Canada advanced to 5,968 barrels in September from the August exportations of 4,986 barrels. Cement imports during September increased to 2,334 barrels as compared with 392 barrels in the preceding month. The September imports consisted of 1,664 barrels from Great Britain and 670 barrels from the United States.



CLAY PRODUCTS - Clay and clay products sold by Canadian producers in September were valued at \$253,433, a 3.9 per cent decline from the total for the preceding month and 22.8 per cent from the September, 1932, sales.

Exports of clay and clay products from Canada decreased 55.3 per cent in value to \$11,813 from the August valuation of \$26,455. Imports of clay and clay products into Canada in September were valued at \$436,128 as compared with \$451,493 in the preceding month. During September the Canadian imports were drawn from the following sources: Great Britain, 44.5 per cent; the United States, 42.9 per cent; Japan, 6.6 per cent; Germany, 3.2 per cent; Czechoslovakia, 1.3 per cent, and France, Italy, Bolgium, Denmark, Hong Kong, Sweden, China, Spain, the Netherlands and Austria, the remainder.

LIME - Canada's lime production in September amounted to 28,601 tons; in August, 30,598 tons were produced and in September, 1932, the output was 28,058 tons. During the nine months ending September the Canadian production was 214,321 tons, a 10.6 per cent falling-off from the total for the corresponding months of 1932.

Exports of lime from Canada amounted to 1,476 tons as compared with 667 tons in the preceding month. Six tons of lime valued at \$155 were imported into Canada from the United States in September; during the previous month 4 tons at \$118 were imported.
