CEMENT, CLAY PRODUCTS AID IIIE PRODUCTION, OCTOBER, 1934.
CEMENT - The Canadian production of cement in October amounted to 480,438 barrels; in the preceding month 499,085 barrels were produced and in October, 1933, the total was 348,639 berrels, eccording to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the ten months ending October, $3,467,879$ barrels of cement were produced in Canada as compared with $2,726,018$ barrels in the corresponding period of 1933.
portland cement exports in october were recorded at 9,179 barrels or 34.3 per cent above the previous month's exportations.

Imports of cement into Canada in october declined to 695 barrels worth $\$ 3,869$ from the september total of 1,179 barrels at $\$ 3,359$. The October importations consisted of 694 barrels from the United States and 1 barrel from Belgium.

CLAY PRODUCTS - Sales of clay and clay products by Canadian producers in October were valued at $\$ 260,322$; in September the total was $\$ 229,497$ and in october, a year ago, $\$ 241,493$. A 6.6 per cent incroase was shown in tho salus of these conmodities during the ten months ending october as compared with the corresponding period of 1933 ; the totals were $\$ 2,059,197$ and $\$ 1,932,380$, respectively.

Clay and clay products exported from Canuda in octobor wero valued at $\$ 10,275$ or $£ 7.5$ per cent bulow the septombor valuation.

The Canudian imports of clay and clay products during octobor woro appraised at $\$ 511,698$ as against the septumbur total of $\$ 422,159$. The October importations were obtained from the following sources: Great Britain, 46.1 per cent; the United Statos, 41.5 per cont; Japan, 8.1 per cent; Germany, 2.9 por cont, and Belgium, Czechoslovakia, France, Italy, China, Hong Kong, Palestino, Swudun, Austrie, and the Nethorlands, the romainder.

LIME - Limo production in Canada reachod a total of 33,990 tons in November as against 29,790 tons in tho previous month and 31,909 tons in Novembor, 1933.

Exports of lime from Canada in November wera recorded at 830 tons; in October l, 205 tons wore exported. spproximatcly ll tons of lime were importod into Canada from the Unitod States in November; during the preceding month only $l$ ton was imported from this source.
