CEMENT, CLAY PRODUCTS AND LINE PRODUCTION, NOVEMBER, 1934.

CEMENT - Portland cement shipments by Canadian producers in November were recorded at 223,347 barrels as compared with 480,338 barrels in October and 182,144 barrels in November, 1833, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Shipments during the period January to November totalled 3,691,226 barrels; in the corresponding months of 1933 the total was 2,908, 162 barrels.

Exports of Portland cement from Canada in November amounted to 12,483 barrels: in the previous month 9,179 barrels were exported.

Cement importations into Canada during November declined to 577 barrels valued at $\$ 2,017$ from the October total of 695 barrels worth $\$ 3,868$. The United States supplied 85.6 per cent of the November imports; the remainder consisted of 74 barrels from Great Britain and 1 barrel from Japan.

PRODUCTION OF CEIDYNI IN CANADA

CLAY PRODUCTS - Canadian producers reported sales of clay and clay products valued at $\$ 207,754$ in November as compared with the October valuation of $\$ 260,322$ and the November, 1933, total of $\{213,865$. During the ulovon months ending November sales of these commodities advanced 5.6 per cunt in value to $\$ 2,266,951$ from the total for the corresponding months of 1933.

Exports of clay and clay products in November wore valued at $\{16,808$ or 63.6 per cent above the proceeding month's valuation.

The value of clay and clay products imported into Canada in November amounted to $\$ 671,105$; this represented an increase of 31.2 per cont over the uctober importations. The November receipts were obtained from the following sources: Great Britain, 51.7 per cont; the United States, 36.1 per cont; Japan, 6.6 per cent; Germany, 2.1 per cent; Belgium, 1.6 per cont; and Czechoslovakia, Italy, Mexico, Palestine, France, China, Hong Kong, tho Netherlands, Norway and Switzerland, the remainder.

LIME - I'ho Canadian production of lime in Decembur amounted to 34,020 tons; in Novombor 33, 990 tons were produced and in Decombor, 1933, the total was 28, 177 tons. During tho calendar year 1934 Canada's output totalled 365,029 tons, an advance of 12.8 per cont over tho procoding year's production.

Thruo hundrod and sevunty-throu tons of lime wore exportud from Canada in Decembor as against 830 tons in Novembur. Exports during the twelve months onding Ducumbur, 1934, wure recorded at 10,675 tons.
\&pproximatoly 2 tons of lima vero importud into Cenade in Ducumber as comparud with 11 tons in tho previous month. During 1934 receipts of lime amounted to 327 tons worth $\{5,118$; a ycur ugo, 272 tons valuod at 44,444 wore importad.
