## CEMENT, CLAY PRODUCTS AND LIME PRODUCTION, FEBRUARY, 1934.

CEMENT - Portland cement shipments from Canadian plants, in February, were reported at 66,571 barrels, a 3.2 per cent decline from the preceding month's total but an advance of 46.9 per cent over the total for February, 1933, according to a statement issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa.

Canada exported 1,410 barrels of Portland coment in February as compared with 847 barrels in January. Imports of cement into Canada in February were recorded at 237 barrels worth \$658; in the previous month 506 barrels at \$2,298 were imported. Great Britain supplied 87.5 per cent of the February imports and the United States the remainder.

CLAY PRODUCTS - Sales of clay and clay products by Canadian producers in February were valued at \$96,428 as against the January valuation of \$115,353 and the February, 1933, value of \$75,138.

Exports of clay and clay products from Canada in February were worth \$13,354, a 38.2 per cent decline from the preceding month's total of \$21,615. India was the principal purchaser of the Canadian clay products exported in February.

Imports of clay and clay products into Canada in February advanced 2.3 per cent in value to \$367,905 from the January valuation of \$359,648. The February importations were obtained from the following sources: Great Britain, 49.3 per cent; the United States, 38.0 per cent; Japan, 9.6 per cent, and Germany, Czechoslovakia, Palestine, France, China, Belgium, Switzerland, Hong Kong, Austria, Sweden, and Italy, the remainder.

LIME - Shipments of lime from Canadian kilns in February rose to 27,388 tons from the preceding month's total of 26,060 tons. In February, 1933, shipments amounted to 17,750 tons.

Canada exported 880 tons of lime in February as against 981 tons in January. Imports of lime into Canada in February were recorded at 16 tons worth \$516; the January imports amounted to 25 tons appraised at \$251.
