

## CEMMINT, CLLAY PRODUCTS IND LIME PHODUCTION, $\mathrm{M} Y, 1934$.

CEMENT - Shipments of Portland cement by Canadian producers in May were reported at 381,562 barrels as comparad with 210,186 barrols in the precoding month and 308,717 barrels in May, 1933, according to a roport just issued by the Domirion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the first five months 834,523 barrels of coment wore produced; in tho corrosponding poriod of 1933 shipments totallod 687,477 barrols.

Exports of Portland cement were recorded at 8,385 barrels in May as against 437 barrels in April.

Canadian imports of cement in May amounted to 1,501 barrels valued at $\$ 5,614 ;$ in the previous month 1,961 barrels worth $\$ 3,062$ were imported. The May receipts consisted of 899 barrels from the United States, 315 barrels from Belgium and 287 barrels from Great Britain.

CLAY PRODUCTS - Canadian producers reported salos of clay and clay products valued at $\$ 258,775$ in May; in the procoding month tho valuc of salus was $\$ 196,762$ and in May, a yoar ago, tho total was $\$ 223,91 \mathrm{l}$. Sulus during tho fivo months onding May were valued at $\$ 797,446$ or 26.2 per cent above the valuation for the corresponding months of 1933.

Clay and clay products exported from Canada in May woro worth $\$ 18,335$ as against the April value of $\$ 2,751$.

Imports of clay and clay products into Canade in May were appraisod at $\$ 680,500$, an advance of 84.6 per cont above tho total for the prucciing month. The May importetions wore obtainca from the following countrics: Groet Britein, 51.1 per cont; the Unitod Statos, 36.8 por cent; Jepan, 8.3 por cent; Gormany, 1.6 per cent; and Bolgium, Czochoslovakí, Frenco, Palostino, Italy, Hong Kong, Chine, Austria, Switzerland, Bermuda and Nowfoundlend, tho romaindur.

LIME - Tho Canadian production of line in iky roached a total of 32,0\%1 tons as compared with 28,653 tons in april and 25,599 tons in May, 1933. Shipmonts during the first five months of 1934 amountod to 148,392 tons, a 50.2 per cent incronso over the total for the corrosponding months of 1933.
