## CEMENT, CLAY PRODUCTS AND LIME PRODUCTION, JULY, 1934.

CEMENT - Portland coment shipments from Canadian plants during July advanced to 564,711 barrels from the preceding month's total of 520,832 barrels and the July, 1933, production of 414,827 barrels, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Shipments during the first seven months of 1934 totalled 1,920,071 barrels as compared with 1,503,364 barrels in the corresponding months of 1933.

Exports of Portland cement from Canada in July amounted to 6,352 barrels; in June, 7,159 barrels were exported.

Canada imported 3,277 barrels of cement worth \$8,278 in July as against 1,970 barrels at \$6,638 in the previous month. Great Britain supplied 57.8 per cent of the July importations; the United States, 30.3 per cent; and Belgium, Italy and Jugoslavia the remainder.

CLAY PRODUCTS - Canadian producers reported sales of clay products to a value of \$267,660 in July; the preceding month's sales were worth \$259,094 and the July, 1933, total was \$255,572. During the seven months ending July the value of sales increased 15.0 per cent to \$1,324,200 from the total for the corresponding period of 1933.

Clay and clay products exported from Canada in July were worth \$6,537 or 43.3 per cent below the June export valuation.

Customs' records show that Canada imported clay and clay products valued at \$503,916; the June valuation was \$543,016. The following countries were the sources of the July importations: Great Britain, 51.8 per cent; the United States, 37.3 per cent; Japan, 7.5 per cent; and Germany, France, Belgium, Italy, Palestine, Austria, Czechoslovakia, Hong Kong, China and Switzerland, the remainder.

LIME - The production of lime in Canada during July amounted to 30,639 tons as compared with 31,984 tons in June and 31,158 tons in July, 1933. During the seven months ending July, 211,015 tons of lime were produced in Canada; during the period January to July, 1933, the output totalled 164,158 tons.

Lime exports from Canada were recorded at 732 tons as against 1,055 tons in the preceding month. Imports of lime advanced to 93 tons at \$1,059 from the June total of 19 tons at \$643.
