## CEMENT, CLAY PRODUCTS AND MINE PRODUCTION, AUGUST, 1934.

CEMENT - Canadian plants produced 567,785 barrels of Portland cement during August as compared with 564, 711 barrels in July and 449,305 barrels in August, 1933, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Shipments during the eight months ending August amounted to 2,487,856 barrels; in the corresponding period of 1935 the total was 1,952,669 barrels.

An advance of 46.1 per cent was recorded in the exportation of Portland cement from Canada; the August exports totalled 9,279 barrels while in July 6,352 barrels were exported.

Imports of cement into Canada declined to 917 barrels worth \$4,716 in August from the July total of 3.277 barrels at \$8,278. The August importations were obtained principally from the United States.

cLAY PRODUCTS - Sales of clay products by Canadian producers in August were valued at \$245,178 as against a value of \$267,660 in July and \$275,090 in August, 1933. During the eight months ending August, 1934, the value of sales of clay products, produced from domestic clays, recorded a 10.0 per cent advance to \$1,569.378 from the total for the corresponding period of 1933.

Canada exported clay and clay products valued at (14,994 in August as compared with the July export tallation of 45,827. The value of the imports of clay and clay products into Canada in .. ugust increased 8.3 per cent to \$545,830 from the July total of \$503,916. The August importations were obtained from the following sources: Great Britain, 49.4 per cent; the United States, 37.4 per cent; Japan, 9.3 per cent, and Germany, Belgium, Italy, France, Palestine, Czechoslovakia, Sweden, China, the Netherlands, Hong Kong, Austria, Cuba, Australia and Poland, the remainder.

LIME - Canada produced 29,249 tons of lime during August; in July 30,639 tons were produced and in August, 1933, the output was 32,381 tons. The total Canadian production during the eight months ending August amounted to 240,264 tons or 22.2 per cent above the tonnage produced in the corresponding months of 1933.

Six hundred and four tons of lime were exported from Canada in August as against 732 tons in the preceding month. Imports of lime declined to 5 tons worth \$121 from the July total of 93 tons valued at \$1,059.
